New Curriculum Proposal on Homeland Security: Cordell Briggs and Natalie Hannum provided an update to the council regarding the status of curriculum development for this proposed certificate program which is being developed with grant funding. One course outline of record (COR) has been approved by the Curriculum Committee and two more CORS are in progress. It is anticipated that all6 courses and the certificate pattern proposal can be ready for Curriculum Committee approval by the end of fall 2009. MVC is one of 40 designated hubs throughout the U.S. working on academic curriculum development in this area. M/S/C (Elder/Middleton/Unanimous) to approve curriculum concept development and forward recommendation for consideration to the Moreno Valley Academic Senate.
