### Individuals should take these courses if they are interested in:

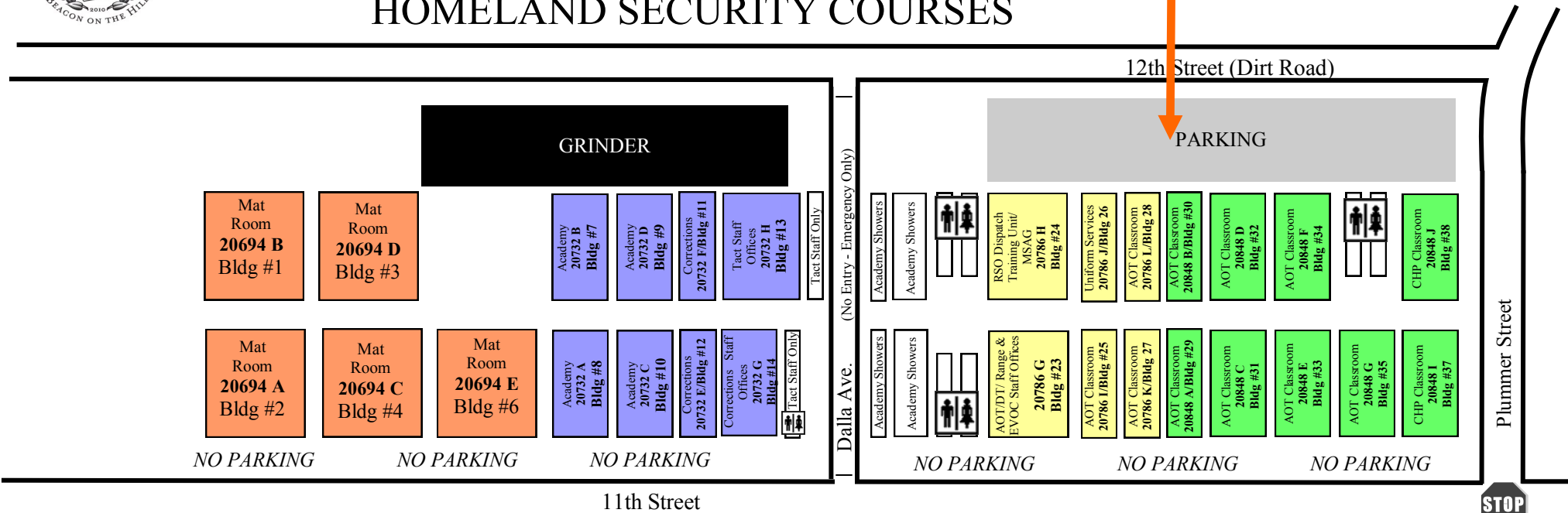
- Learning how to prepare themselves better, their family and their community for a critical incident.
