COURSE TITLE:		CORRECTIONAL DEPUTY ACADEMY			
OVERVIEW:	<p>The Basic Correctional Deputy Academy is a 368-hour course that exceeds the minimum training requirements of section 179 of the California Code of Regulations and meets the 832 P.C. training requirements of 831.5 P.C.</p> <p>In addition to the STC requirements, this course includes Hostage Management, Interview and Interrogation, Baton Techniques, Carotid Restraint, Chemical Agents (OC), Less-Lethal Munitions, First Aid & CPR Certification, Officer Liability, Drill and Ceremony, Staff Sexual Misconduct with Inmates, Basic English and Grammar Skills, Gangs, Defensive Tactics, and Emergency Response Training (ERT).</p> <p>All students who successfully graduate will participate in a formal graduation ceremony.</p>

LODGING:	Reservations for lodging must be arranged by the students or by their agencies. Low cost, dormitory-style lodging is available on site. For information on lodging, please contact Cherie Pearson at 951-486-2726.
PREREQUI SITE:	Students must be in excellent physical condition. A statement of physical and medical fitness from a physician is required. College students must have successfully completed the Orientation to the Correctional Deputy Academy (ADJ804) prior to the academy start date.
ENROLLMENT:	This course is limited to 50 students and reservations will be made on a first-come, first-served basis. For enrollment contact the course coordinator.
INSTRUCTORS:	All instructors are experienced in their fields and are STC-certified.
DRESS CODE WILL BE ENFORCED:	<p>Two tan short sleeve shirts, “Flying Cross” brand. Shirts will have a green cloth name tag with tan lettering. The student’s last name will be embroidered in block print and sewn over the right shirt pocket. Individual agency patches will be sewn on both shoulders. <i>There should not be any badges on the shirt during the academy.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> White crew neck T-shirt. Two olive green battle dress uniform (BDU) pants, “Tru-Spec” brand (of sufficient length to allow the cuffs to be bloused.) Black basket-weave belt. Black socks. Black military style boots. Boots must be all black, and capable of being polished to a high luster. <p style="text-align: center;">PHYSICAL TRAINING AND DEFENSIVE TACTICS UNIFORM</p> <p>Dark green crew neck short sleeve shirt with Clark Training Center logo on the left front. Student’s last name displayed on the front and back in two-inch high block letters.</p> <p>Dark green long sleeve pullover sweatshirt with Clark Training Center logo on the left front. Student’s last name displayed on the front and back in two-inch high block letters.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dark green sweat pants. Black nylon running shorts. Black nylon compression shorts. These resemble, but are lighter in weight, than bicycle shorts. Compression shorts are available at Galls Uniforms, but do not have to be purchased there. Remove or color over with pen any labels or logos. <p>White socks. No logos or colored stripes. Length of sock is up to the student, but no higher than just below the calf.</p> <p>Running shoes are the single most important part of this gear. Do not purchase ‘cross-training’ or ‘trail running’ shoes. These should be purchased and broken in before the academy starts.</p>
CERTIFICATION:	This course is certified by Standards and Training for Corrections.
CANCELLATION:	This course is co-sponsored by the Riverside County Sheriff’s Department, Ben Clark Training Center. Courses are offered based on scheduled attendance. Once scheduled, failure to attend, or cancel at least ten days prior to the start of the class will result in a charge for the full course fee, less any applicable college unit fees. An alternate student, from the same agency may fill the reservation.
