

Children's Use of the Library
Moreno Valley College Library Procedure

Library personnel are not responsible for the safety, care, or supervision of minor children of any age in the Moreno Valley College Library. Children under 14 years of age may not be left unattended in the Library and must be accompanied by an adult over 18 years of age. Library personnel are authorized to call College Safety and Police to enforce this procedure.

The Library does not censor Library materials. Therefore, supervision or restriction of a minor's access to the Internet or other Library material is the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian.

- Patrons of all ages are expected to follow all library procedures regarding noise, disruption, food, and computer use.

- Patrons must be at least 16 years old to obtain a Community Borrowers card.

- Parents or legal guardians should be aware of the content of Riverside Community College District policy to report suspected abuse and neglect of minors present at any time on District property (BP 3518 Child Abuse Reporting).
