# Spring 2022 Enrollment Snapshot

- ❖ Spring 2022 Projecting 2048.76 FTES
  - ❖ Compared to Pre-Covid SP19  
Down 635.05 FTES or -23.7%
  - ❖ Compared to SP21  
Down 117.94 FTES or -5.4%
- ❖ Year to Date Projecting 5244.74 FTES
  - ❖ Compared to Pre-COVID 18-19 Year  
Down 1924.62 FTES or -26.8%
  - ❖ Compared to 20-21  
Down 893.56 FTES or -14.6%



# Strategic Enrollment Management Taskforce

- ❖ Meetings to Begin in March – Every 2 Weeks
- ❖ Completed Plan Expected By May/June 2022





# To Come on Site - Who Should Get Weekly Testing?



- ❖ Students/Employees with accommodations (religious/medical)
- ❖ Students/Employees that are due for booster
  - ❖ Once eligible to get the booster you will be given 30 days to get the shot
- ❖ Testing NOT REQUIRED for Students/Employees who are NOT due for a Booster

## ShieldT3 -COVID-19 Testing Services

- ❖ Student Academic Services (SAS) build. Rm #121
- ❖ Monday-Thursday from 8am to 6pm; Fridays from 8am to 3pm
- ❖ For Students/Faculty/Staff Only
- ❖ Both PCR (Saliva) and Rapid Antigen (Nasal Swab) Testing Available
- ❖ **Automatically uploads results to Cleared4**
- ❖ Results within 24 hours for PCR and 30 minutes for Rapid Antigen

## CURATIVE -COVID-19 Testing Services

- ❖ MVC Parking Lot E
- ❖ Monday through Friday from , 10 am –5:30 pm (Close for lunch 2 –2:30 pm)
- ❖ Nasal Swab PCR Test
- ❖ **Manual upload results to Cleared4**
- ❖ By Appointment Only
- ❖ Results received within ~ 1-2 days
