

Admissions & Records **Adult Education Concurrent Enrollment School Approval Form**

Eligible adult education students may attend Moreno Valley College if they demonstrate college readiness. Interested adult education students must meet the following requirement:

Be enrolled in an adult education program completing a high school diploma, GED, or equivalency

certificate
Students who meet these requirements must submit the following items in order for eligibility to be determined:

- MVC Online Admission Application Confirmation Page
- Official Transcripts (in a sealed envelope and printed no more than ninety days ago) or official documentation of enrollment from your adult school
- School Approval Form (signed by all required parties)

Incomplete packets will not be accepted. In order to be considered for the Adult Education Concurrent Enrollment program, original documents of all the required items must be submitted to the Admissions & Records Office in person or through email at least two weeks before the term begins. The email is admissions@mvc.edu.
