Program Overview

The California Dream Act Service Incentive Grant (DSIG) Program encourages California Dream Act Applicant (CADAA) students to perform community or volunteer service. The California Student Aid Commission (CSAC) will award up to \$4,500 per academic year (up to \$2,250 per semester or up to \$1,500 per quarter) to 1,667 eligible students. The grant will be available to the student for up to 8 semesters or up to 12 quarters while they have an active Cal Grant A or B award.

Who is an Eligible Student?

- Completed and submitted California Dream Act Application (CADAA) for that academic year.
- Is an active recipient of a Cal Grant A or Cal Grant B award. Cal Grant A recipients must have met Cal Grant B eligibility.
- Demonstrate enough financial need (determined by CSAC or the institution).
- Enrolled in a qualifying institution.

Qualifying Service Organization

- A nonprofit as defined in Section 501(c)(3) of the IRS code.
- Any federal, state, or local government entity.
- Any school on the Cal Grant Eligible Schools list on the CSAC website.
- Organization shall have been established for a minimum of two (2) years prior to the date that the student begins to perform service.
- Community or volunteer service performed is not advocacy of a political, social, or religious nature.
- Service is related to the participating student's field of study or is in furtherance of community service or a community

The privacy of students personally identifying information (PII) is of the utmost importance to the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC). This information and notice is provided in compliance with and subject to the requirements of Article 1, Section I, of the California Constitution, the Information Practices Act of 1977 ("IPA") (Cal. Information requested on all CSAC forms is collected and maintained pursuant to the legal requirements noted above and CSAC's statutory duties as established by Education Code Section 69514.

Social Security Numbers

CSAC collects personal demographic information including the Social Security number (SSN) to verify your identity, to protect your individual information from access by others, to determine your eligibility for state student aid funds, and to track the state student aid funds you receive. CSAC complies with the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act and does not share your SSN with federal or other state entities except as prescribed by law. Such data is maintained by CSAC in highly secure databases and/or encrypted form to protect against loss, unauthorized access, use, modification or disclosure.

The information requested is mandatory unless indicated as "optional". The consequences of not providing complete and accurate information may result in a prolonged delay in determining eligibility or an incorrect eligibility determination.

Conditions of Disclosure

Pursuant to established law and CSAC's Privacy Policy, Commission employees may not disclose any personal information in a manner which would link the information to the individual to whom it pertains (See Section 1798.3, IPA). Portions of personal information may be disclosed to other state agencies, educational institutions, and researchers, but only in strict accordance with current statutes regarding confidentiality and CSAC's Policy.
