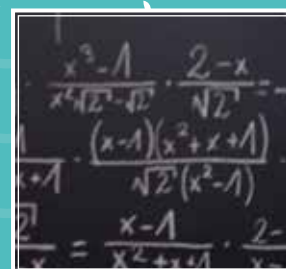

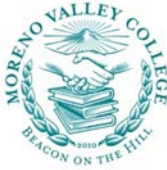

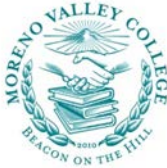

- A grade of C or better in ENG-50 or ENG-80

ENGLISH 50

- Qualifying preparation score based on the ACCUPLACER® test and academic background; or
- Successful completion of ENG-60B or ESL-55

ENGLISH 80

- There is no prerequisite; the course is open to all students.

ENGLISH 60B

- Qualifying preparation score based on the ACCUPLACER® test and academic background; or
- Successful completion of ENG-60A

ENGLISH 60A

- There is no prerequisite; the course is open to all students.

It is strongly recommended that students register in an appropriate composition course (ENG-60A, 60B, 80, 50, or ENG-1A) during their first semester of enrollment. See "Moving through English" for more details.

In association with local, state and federal agencies, Moreno Valley College offers one of the largest public safety training programs in Southern California. Each year, the college prepares hundreds of students to work as law enforcement officers, firefighters, emergency medical technicians, paramedics, dispatchers, and correctional officers.

Most of the training occurs at the BCTC, located adjacent to March Air Force Reserve Base. The Ben Clark Training Center is recognized nationally for its innovative, interagency programs that emphasize state-of-the-art training for law enforcement, emergency medical services and firefighting personnel to function as a team.

Several major public agencies participate in public safety training, including the Riverside County Sheriff's Department, the Riverside County Fire Department, the California Department of Forestry and the Department of Corrections.
