

Questions to Ask College Representatives

There are a lot of colleges that you can choose from, so the key is to find the right fit for you. Be prepared to meet with University Representatives, please review the list of questions below.

WHAT IS YOUR CAMPUS AND COMMUNITY LIKE?

- Are you on Semester or Quarter system? When do classes begin?
- What kinds of social, cultural, recreational activities are available on the campus and in the community?
- Are there internship opportunities available on campus, or in the community?
- Can I enroll part-time, take courses in the late afternoon, evening, weekends or during the summer?

HOW MUCH DOES YOUR COLLEGE COST?

- What is the cost of tuition, books, supplies, housing and parking? When do I pay for those fees?
- What are the chances that the fees will increase and when will I know?
- Do I have to send in a deposit to confirm my intention to enroll? How much and when?

WHAT TYPE OF FINANCIAL AID IS AVAILABLE?

- When and how do I apply for financial aid? When will I know if I qualify for financial assistance?
- Are there scholarships available that I can apply for?
- Are there employment opportunities available on campus?

WHAT ARE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION?

- What are your admission requirements for transfer students?
- Will courses that I received a "D" in count?
- What are the admission priorities for students transferring from a community college to a 4 year college?
- Do you have special programs for students of certain ethnic minority and/or other underrepresented groups? How can I qualify? What types of services do the special programs provide?

HOW DO I APPLY FOR ADMISSION?

- Where is the application located and when are the application deadlines?
- When do I have to submit transcripts, test scores and other admission materials?
- Is my major impacted? If so, what special requirements do I need? If I am not accepted into my major, what are my alternative options? Can I change to another major?

WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW?

- How do I make arrangements to take a tour of your campus?
- Do you have an open house for prospective students? Who do I contact for further information?
