



P.C. 832 FIREARMS

The Firearms component of the P.C. 832 course is a 24-hour course which covers topics such as firearm safety, handgun familiarization, firearms care and cleaning, shooting principles, and range qualification. This course is designed to provide the students with the firearms safety factors and precautions, firearms shooting principles including range firing of handguns.

In order to receive a certificate of completion for the course, you need to successfully pass the Firearms Skill Examination. ANY student with a convicted felony and certain misdemeanors will not be allowed to possess a firearm in California. NOTE: Agency letterheads will no longer be accepted. All agency-sponsored students will need to obtain a DOJ clearance letter as well. DOJ letters over six months old at the start of class will not be accepted. You will earn **0.5 units of college credits**.
